AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Justices upon Retirement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘The compensation herein provided shall not be made available to any of said justices who, after retirement, engages in the practice of law and any such justice who is engaged in such practice of law at the time this act takes effect shall be deemed to have waived further compensation hereunder.’
