IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Millinocket for Support of Charles Roy and Family.

Town of Millinocket; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,663.36 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Millinocket, to reimburse it for expenses incurred in the support of Charles Roy and family, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It has been discovered that the state is liable for the support of Mr. Roy and family, and this resolve is for money expended by the town of Millinocket.
