STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Build Fishway on Meduxnekeag River.

Fishway on Meduxnekeag; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$4000 to be expended, or so much thereof as may be necessary, by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, for the erection of a fishway on the Meduxnekeag river in the Province of New Brunswick. Provided, however, that said appropriation shall not be available until some responsible person, corporation, or incorporated fish and game club, shall have agreed to assume all liability for the keeping of the fishway, at all times, free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of the water through the same.

Any and all acts done in compliance with this resolve in the Province of New Brunswick shall be with the consent and approval of said province.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are a great many salmon in this river, but they cannot go above the falls and dam. These are the only obstructions in the river.
