RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Peters Pond.

Fishing in Peters pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, closing Peters pond in Waldoboro, county of Lincoln, to ice fishing and establishing a daily bag limit of 5 fish per person during the legal open season.
