RESOLVE, Regulating Hunting and Trapping of Muskrats.

Hunting and trapping of muskrats, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue the following rule and regulation regulating the hunting and trapping of muskrats:

‘Closing Lake Alamoosook and Dead river and tributaries in Orland in the county of Hancock for a period of 3 years.’
