RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land to Maxime Albert of Sinclair.

Forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Maxime Albert of Sinclair, the interest of the state in 58 acres in 168 acre parcel of land with buildings thereon in T. 17, R. 4, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county, for the sum of \$86.89.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land was formerly assessed to Maxime Albert, and was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1938 for 1936 taxes. The federal farm mortgage corporation is desirous of obtaining this lot with buildings thereon by paying the taxes in arrears. The taxes in arrears with interest and advertising from 1936 to 1940 inclusive amount to \$86.89. The federal farm mortgage corporation now holds a mortgage on this property, but requests that the release be made to Maxime Albert and send same in care of the Federal Land Bank, Springfield, Mass. Check for \$86.89 is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
