STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Authorizing the Town of Island Falls to Raise Money.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town authorized to raise money. The inhabitants of the town of Island Falls at any meeting legally called for said purpose, any such meeting being hereby authorized, are hereby authorized and empowered to raise money by taxation to assist in, and to be expended in, repairing and rebuilding the county road in the town of Dyer Brook, extending from state highway No. 2 to the east line of land of John H. Lane in said town of Dyer Brook; provided the town of Dyer Brook shall raise a like amount for said purpose. Said amounts so raised shall constitute a joint fund to be expended at one time for said purpose under the supervision of the selectmen of the respective towns.
