STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Pauper Settlements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Acquiring pauper settlement limited. During the period that a family is supported in part by surplus commodities, so-called, or wages received from the Works Progress Administration under the provisions of federal law, or old age assistance, no member of the said family shall acquire or lose a pauper settlement, or be in the process of acquiring or losing a pauper settlement.
- Sec. 2. Amending clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, or amended to conform with the provisions hereof.
