RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Anson.

Town of Anson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,944.22 to be paid to the town of Anson to reimburse said town for support of Frank Lewis, state pauper; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Frank Lewis was a state pauper. The town could not obtain the proper facts to prove the status of this pauper in time to conform with the statutes.
