RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Cumberland and York Counties.

Fishing in York County, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of not more than 15 trout per person per day from any or all waters in Cumberland and York Counties.
