STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to the Taking of Smelts in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 29, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 29 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following inserted in place thereof:

'It shall be unlawful to take smelts in any of the inland waters of York county above tide waters in any manner from March 20th to May 20th each year. Smelts may be taken in the day time only, with single baited hook and line in the lakes and ponds in York county from May 21st of each year to September 30th, both dates inclusive. Smelts may also be taken in the lakes and ponds opened to ice fishing in York county, with single baited hook and line from the time the ice forms to the following March 19th inclusive. Whoever violates the provisions of this paragraph shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10, nor more than \$30 and costs for each offense and in addition thereto, \$1 for each fish taken and caught in violation of this paragraph.'
