**AN ACT Relative to Pollution in Presumpscot River, Salmon Falls
River, Mousam River and Saco River.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, §36, ¶3, amended. Paragraph 3 of section 36 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The following rivers and their branches are exempted from the provisions of the preceding paragraphs: ~~Salmon Falls river, Mousam river, Saco river, Presumpscot river,~~ Androscoggin river, Kennebec river, Penobscot river, St. Croix river, St. John river, and Fish river. **The following rivers also, but none of their branches or tributaries shall be exempted from the provisions of the preceding paragraphs: Presumpscot river, Salmon Falls river, Mousam river, and Saco river.** Whoever violates any provision of this section shall pay a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$100 and costs for each offense.
