RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Convey Certain Land to J. C. Briggs of Caribou.

Forestry department authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey the interest of the state in the following described lot to J. C. Briggs, of Caribou, for the sum of \$74.03: a 26 acre parcel of land in T. 17, R. 4, W.E.L.S., Aroostook county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land was formerly owned by Charles Dionne, and was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1938 for 1936 taxes. Mr. Briggs is desirous of obtaining this lot by paying the taxes in arrears as he holds a mortgage on part of the property and a deed on the remainder. The taxes in arrears with interest and costs to 1940 inclusive, amount to \$74.03. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
