STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of a Bridge Across the Allagash River.

Appropriation for bridge across the Allagash river. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$62,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, to be paid from the general highway fund for the state's share in the cost of building a bridge over the Allagash river in Allagash plantation. Any unexpended balance of this appropriation shall be available for the continuation of the project if it is not completed within the first fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1938 there was a hearing on the construction of this bridge by the joint board; highway commissioner, county commissioners and the selectment of Allagash plantation. It was the decision of this board that the bridge be built.
