RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing on Long Pond.

Fishing on Long pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, prohibiting fishing from Castle Island bridge on Long pond, in Mt. Vernon and Belgrade, county of Kennebec, until after June 20th each year.
