RESOLVE, in Favor of a Fish Screen in Cathance Lake.

Fish screen and dam in Cathance lake to be repaired. Resolved: That the sum of \$850 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general funds to be expended under the supervision of the department of inland fisheries and game to repair and rebuild the fish screen and dam located at the outlet of Cathance lake in Plantation No. 14, in Washington county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The fishway and dam at Cathance lake are both badly in need of repair. If not repaired at once, there is danger of losing the majority of the fish in the lake.
