RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Caribou.

Town of Caribou; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Caribou, the sum of \$175,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, for the reconstruction of the bridge over Aroostook river in said town of Caribou; said sum to be taken from the general highway funds. Any unexpended balance at the end of the fiscal year shall be available for use on the same in any succeeding fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bridge is on the main road from Caribou to Fort Fairfield, route 161. It is approximately 500 feet long and was built in 1892. The roadway width is 16 feet, too narrow for traffic, and the bridge is entirely too light to carry the legal load allowed on the highway. The amount of \$175,000 is the estimate made in 1940 by the state highway department.
