STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT to Dissolve Dexter and Piscataquis Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Dexter and Piscataquis Railroad Company, dissolved. The sale and conveyance of the property and franchises of Dexter and Piscataquis Railroad Company to Maine Central Railroad Company, and the assumption by Maine Central Railroad Company of the bonded indebtedness, the mort-gage securing the same, and other indebtedness of Dexter and Piscataquis Railroad Company, are approved, confirmed and declared to be valid, and said Dexter and Piscataquis Railroad Company is hereby dissolved.

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
