**AN ACT Relative to Closed Season on Partridge in Cumberland and
York Counties.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, §55, ¶2, amended. Paragraph 2 of section 55 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘There shall be a closed season on partridge from November 16th to September 30th of the following year, both days inclusive, and no person shall, during the open season, have in possession in any 1 day more than 4 partridge, or in any 1 open season for partridge or ruffed grouse more than 25 of the above named birds, nor shall any person at any time buy or sell any partridge or ruffed grouse. **Provided, however that there shall be a closed season on partridge in Cumberland and York Counties from November 1st to September 30th, both days inclusive.**’
