# STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Bion M. Rhoades of Topsfield.

Bion M. Rhoades; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1057.20 to be paid to Bion M. Rhoades, of Tops-field, as a full and final settlement for all claims against the state for damage to growing crops by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

### Statement of Facts

During the past 3 or 4 years, deer have destroyed Mr. Rhoades' potato crops, alfalfa crops, and fields. Mr. Rhoades notified A. L. Grover of the Inland Fisheries and Game, and was referred to the legislature.
