IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Dover-Foxcroft for Expenses of a State Pauper.

Town of Dover-Foxcroft, reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1967.20 to reimburse the town of Dover-Foxcroft for relief furnished to Kennebec E. Severance and family, a state pauper; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

Statement of Facts

The liability for this pauper was in dispute for a long time. On September 19, 1940, the courts decided that K. E. Severance was a state pauper. In the interim, the town of Dover-Foxcroft had found it necessary to support this family and incurred the above bill.
