RESOLVE, Regulating Trapping of Muskrats in Corundel Lake.

Trapping of muskrats in Corundel lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Corundel lake and tributaries and all waters in the town of Newport, county of Penobscot, to the taking of muskrats, except that muskrats may be taken during the month of April only, each year.
