STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Time on Wild Hares and Rabbits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 71, amended. Section 71 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended so that the first sentence thereof shall read as follows:

'There shall be a an annual closed season on wild hares or rabbits from the 1st day of March April to the 30th day of the following September November, both days inclusive, except in the counties of Franklin and Somerset where there shall be a closed season from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive.'
