RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Chase's Pond.

Fishing in Chase's pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Chase's pond in York, county of York, to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring and for all fish (except bass) during February and March.
