RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Moose Pond, Little.

Fishing in Moose pond, Little, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Moose pond, Little in Denmark, county of Oxford, to ice fishing for pickerel from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.
