RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Manns Mill Pond, Little Poverty Pond and Shy Beaver Pond.

Fishing in Manns Mill pond, Little Poverty pond and Shy Beaver pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue rules and regulations, opening Manns Mill pond in Newfield, Little Poverty Pond in Shapleigh and Shy Beaver pond in Shapleigh, all in York county, to ice fishing for pickerel, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs, white perch and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring and for all fish (except bass) during February and March.
