AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the City of Presque Isle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 29, Art. V, amended. Article V of chapter 29 of the private and special laws of 1939, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new section to be numbered section 13 and to read as follows :

‘Sec. 13. Pensions for city employees. The city council may retire from active service and place upon a pension roll, any employee who has attained the age of 65 years and who has been employed in any department of the city with a good record for a term of 20 years, or more; and he shall be allowed such amount as may be determined, not to exceed, yearly, $\frac{1}{2}$ the average annual wage or salary he was receiving for the 5 years previous to the time of his retirement.’
