STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Date of Inspection of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1939, c. 169, §1. The 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 169 of the public laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Such inspection shall be made during the months of May and November October of each year at an official inspection station, duly appointed and certified as such by the secretary of state. If, at the time of such inspection and before the said vehicle is again operated upon the highway, the condition of said vehicle conforms in each and every respect as required by law, an official sticker as a certificate of inspection furnished by said secretary shall be placed in the upper right-hand corner of the windshield or in the center of the windshield back of the rear mirror. Said inspection shall not apply to motor vehicles owned and registered in another state, provided proper proof is shown of an inspection of such motor vehicle within the period of 6 months prior thereto.'
