**RESOLVE, Relating to Maintenance of the White Schoolhouse Road,
So-called.**

Maintenance of White Schoolhouse road. Resolved: That the White Schoolhouse road, so-called, in the town of Madison, shall hereafter be maintained by the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The White Schoolhouse road is a part of Route 148, from Madison Village easterly to the Skowhegan-Bingham highway. It is a heavily travelled highway and should rightfully be maintained by the State as are State Aid highways. The road is about 4½ miles long.
