IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Certain Townships in Piscataquis County.

Certain townships in Piscataquis county; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of the townships of Township 1, Range 9; Township 2, Range 9; Township 2, Range 10; Township 3, Range 10; and Township 4, Range 10, all said townships in Piscataquis county, the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, and \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1943, to aid in the repair and maintenance of the Sourdnahunk road in and across said townships. The money appropriated shall be taken from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is an important trunk line, and badly in need of repair. There are 28 miles of road to be maintained.
