STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Apportionment of School Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 209, amended. Section 209 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 209. Apportionment on basis of aggregate attendance. On the basis of information furnished to the commissioner of education by the return of educational statistics for the year ending July 1st, annually, as provided for by section 58, the commissioner of education shall apportion to the several towns the amount available for this purpose 1½c per day per pupil on the basis of the aggregate attendance of pupils in elementary and secondary schools maintained by those towns; funds for this purpose to be provided from the general funds of the state.'
