AN ACT Relating to Apportionment of School Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 208, amended. Section 208 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 208. Apportionment on basis of school census. On the basis of the school census of the towns on April 1st, annually, as returned under the provisions of section 57, the commissioner of education shall apportion to each town the amount of \$3 for each person returned in the school census for said town. **Provided, however, that when in any year the amount remaining in the state school fund after the apportionment on account of teaching positions provided in section 207 of this chapter is insufficient to pay to the several towns the amount of \$3 for each child of census age, a sum sufficient to make up such deficiency shall be allocated to the state school fund from the general funds of the state.'**
