RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Chase's Mill Stream.

Fishing in Chase's Mill stream, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, closing Chase's Mill stream in East Machias, county of Washington to the taking of fish, except that fish may be taken with a rod and line under the general law.
