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**AN ACT Relating to Re-valuation Surveys.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Surveys for re-valuation of property may be made.** Whenever it shall appear to the assessors of towns, plantations or to the mayor and aldermen (or city council) and assessors of cities that public necessity requires a re-valuation of the physical property in their respective municipalities, they may make a written application, signed by all of them, to the state tax assessor for his aid in making a survey thereof for such re-valuation purposes; such state tax assessor shall grant such assistance as may be required. All applications shall be made upon blanks furnished by the state tax assessor for said purpose.
