STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Town Clerks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, additional. Chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 20-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 20-A. Expenses. Town and city clerks shall be entitled to receive the actual expenses incurred by them in attending the annual meeting of the Maine City and Town Clerks' Association from their town or city; the same to be audited by the municipal officers, and paid out of the town or city treasury.'
