STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting Towns to Appropriate Money in Anticipation of State Appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 28, §75, amended. Section 75 of chapter 28 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 75. Towns having money to become available from state for road or bridge work may anticipate expenditure. Any town to which, under any legislative enactment or resolve, money will become available for road and bridge work at the begining of the fiscal year, may en er at any time after the fifteenth day of April preceding the commencement of the fiscal year for which such appropriation is made, anticipate the expenditure of any appropriation for repair or improvement of a highway or bridge, by arranging to finance such work from funds of the town, or otherwise, prior to the date when such appropriation will become available.'
