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**AN ACT Relating to Fees for Registration of Motor Vehicles.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 29, § 57, amended.** Section 57 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, as hereby further amended by inserting after the schedule of fees for the registration of motor vehicles and before the paragraph next following said schedule the following:

**‘Provided, that the fee for motor trucks of any rated carrying capacity, when equipped with pneumatic tires, used exclusively in the operation of the personal business of persons engaged in agricultural pursuits in this state, and not for hire, shall be \$10; and all such trucks, if of more than 1000 pounds carrying capacity shall display registration plates bearing the words “Farmer’s License” in addition to such other words, figures and devices as may be required by this chapter or approved by the secretary of state. The provisions of paragraph (b) of section 40 of this chapter shall apply to trucks as before described in this paragraph, owned or operated by non-residents in any other state which grants like privileges to such trucks registered in this state.’**
