IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Improvement of Fort Knox Reservation.

Improvement of Fort Knox Reservation authorized. Resolved: That the superintendent of buildings is hereby authorized and directed to cut and remove and sell or arrange for the sale of the right to cut and remove so much of the spruce and fir pulp wood from the Fort Knox reservation in the town of Prospect as will not detract from the beauty of the scenery.

The proceeds from such sale shall be expended under the direction of the state highway commission to build a suitable road on the reservation property from the state highway to the granite wharves on the reservation on the Penobscot river. Also to build fireplaces, tables and shelters; and to do any other work to provide facilities for picnic parties and the general public.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This project will result in the improvement of the reservation at no cost to the state.
