RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Land to Clara Calder Johnston of Rockwood.

Forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Clara Calder Johnston, of Rockwood, the interest of the state in a 40 acre tract with buildings thereon in T. I, R. I, N. B. K. P., Somerset county, for the sum of \$180.59.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land was formerly assessed to Mrs. Johnston's brother, the late Wm. J. Calder, and was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1936 for 1934 taxes. Mrs. Johnston is desirous of obtaining this lot with buildings thereon by paying the taxes in arrears as she did not realize he was not paying his taxes until she searched through his papers. The taxes in arrears with interest and cost to 1940 inclusive amount to \$180.59. Mrs. Johnston has sent in part payment amounting to \$75.59, and says she will send in the balance as soon as she can.
