RESOLVE, in Favor of Florence Dennison of Whiting.

Florence Dennison, compensated. Resolved: That the sum of \$2000 be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Florence Dennison of Whiting, as a full and final settlement against the state for damages sustained by reason of an accident caused by a fault in a bridge approach; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Dennison was riding in an automobile and as it reached Dunn bridge, so-called, in Trescott, by reason of a depression in the immediate approach thereto, she was violently thrown to the top of the automobile so that she sustained a broken back from which injury she is slowly recovering. Said amount is for medical and hospital treatment.
