STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Trapping in the Town of Scarboro.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 72-B, repealed. Section 72-B of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed.
