STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to Closed Time on Wild Hares and Rabbits in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 71, amended. The first sentence of section 71 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a closed season on wild hares or rabbits from the 1st day of March to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive, except in the **county** counties of Franklin and Somerset where there shall be a closed season from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive.'
