RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Ross Pond.

Fishing in Ross pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, establishing a daily limit, on Ross pond in Bristol, county of Lincoln, of 5 fish per person.
