RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Lincoln County Waters.

Fishing in certain Lincoln county waters, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation, opening Duck Puddle pond in Nobleboro and Waldoboro, Damariscotta lake, Little and Big Medomak ponds in Waldoboro, Cooks pond in Nobleboro and Big and Little Dyers pond in Jefferson, all in the county of Lincoln, to white perch fishing on April 1st each year.
