RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Tributaries of Lake Auburn.

Fishing in tributaries of Lake Auburn, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Townsend brook to fishing from April 10 in each year from Lake Auburn to a point marked with 2 red posts, and opening the inlet at the northern part of Lake Auburn to fishing up to the stone dam.
