RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Bear, Wayne and Upper Range Ponds.

Fishing in Bear, Wayne and Upper Range ponds, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Bear pond in Oxford and Androscoggin counties, Wayne pond in Kennebec and Androscoggin counties, and Upper Range pond in Cumberland and Androscoggin counties to fishing after April 10th of each year.
