RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Wilson Pond.

Fishing in Wilson pond; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Wilson pond, in Monmouth, county of Kennebec, to fishing for white perch at all times.
