RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Belgrade Chain of Lakes.

Fishing in Belgrade Chain of Lakes; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that the length of small mouth black-bass that may be taken in the Belgrade Chain of Lakes be changed from 12 inches to 10 inches.
