RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing on Great Lake in Belgrade.

Ice fishing in Great Lake regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Great Lake in the Belgrade Chain to ice fishing on Saturdays during the months of January and February for pickerel and pike only.
