STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Time of the Closing of Polls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 8, § 21, amended. Section 21 of chapter 8 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 21. Time of opening and closing polls. Meetings for the election of state and county officers, and for the election of municipal officers in cities, may be open at 6 o'clock in the forenoon, and shall be opened not later than 10 o'clock in the forenoon; the polls shall be kept open until 7 o'clock in the afternoon, and shall then be closed. In towns and cities using daylight time, the polls shall be closed at 7 o'clock in the afternoon according to daylight time. , except that in In towns of 300 inhabitants or less, the towns shall have the option of closing the polls at 5 o'clock in the afternoon. Notice of the time of opening and closing shall be given in the warrant calling the meeting.'
